	From 8 January 2018 to 9 February 2018, Crawley residents were invited to share their feedback on the proposed icons and images to be used on the new town centre signs, by completing an online survey at www.crawley.gov.uk/consultation .

	The findings concluded that the use of abstract shapes is a central part of the place brand, however, based on the feedback received, the icons which represent objects and activities will be used more prominently than
