Action Taken Under Delegated Authority (Significant Operational Decision): Crawley Unsupervised Play Areas

In March 2023, the Cabinet Member for Wellbeing agreed to group the remaining 8 approved unsupervised play area schemes together within one tender as set out in report HCS/056. Through this report the Cabinet Member for Wellbeing agreed to delegate authority to the Head of Community Services, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Wellbeing, to conduct any further review stage/s and agree where necessary to reprioritise the order of delivery for the relevant phase of the Investment Programme.

Officers conducted a multi-tender process which closed on 13 September 2023. On 14 February 2024 the Head of Community Services, in consultation with the Chief Executive, Head of Commercial Services and the Cabinet Member for Leisure and Wellbeing, awarded the multi-tender contract to the successful bidder to deliver the remaining 8 approved schemes over 2023/24 and 2024/25.
