Councillors Written Questions and the Responses

Full Council – 22 February 2023

Question to Councillor Gurinder Jhans (Cabinet Member for Wellbeing) from Councillor Jaggard

At the July 2019 Full Council meeting, it was agreed that the Civil Enforcement Officers' current pattern of patrols be adapted to ensure patrols outside of our primary schools during the drop-off and pick-up times, please state for this academic year so far:

- 1. The dates and times each of Crawley's Primary/Junior and Infant schools have been patrolled?*
- 2. How many Civil Enforcement penalties were issued at each location?*

Response

Attendance to schools across the borough is now part of the service's regular deployments and routes. The service also responds to enforcement requests made by Members, the public, schools and the Police. For the academic year to date, our CEOs have attended schools on 37 occasions. The detail is set out in the attached spreadsheet.

The spreadsheet (shown below) also sets out that 7 PCNs were issued during these visits. It is important to note that the primary function of the enforcement patrols is to discourage contravention, and that enforcement can only take place where there are legally enforceable restrictions in place.

Recognising that this is a challenging issue for all school sites across the borough, Parking Services is working closely with the Police to request PCSOs attend schools where there are no relevant restrictions, as they have additional powers to move on traffic that Council Officers do not hold.
