	On 24 June 2020, Cabinet (report PES/364) approved in principle that the Council took part in the EV Charging Infrastructure Network scheme, lee WSCC. A competitive single procurement exercise, led by West Sussest County Council and including Crawley Borough Council, Horsham District Council, Mid Sussex District Council, Arun District Council, Adur District Council and Worthing Borough Council has now been undertaken in accordance with the Public Concession Contracts Regulations 2016 (& Public Contracts Regulations 2015) to award a contract for the West Sussex Electric Vehicle Charge-point Network.	ed by x rict t

with the Leader and Cabinet Member for Environmental Services and Sustainability, took the decision on 27 August 2021, to approve of the Council entering into the EV Chargepoint Network scheme, led by WSCC, who have awarded the concession contract for the West Sussex Electric Vehicle Chargepoint Network for fifteen years to commence on 1 November 2021 with an option to extend for a further five years.
