<p>3 <b>Response to Councillor Question Asked at the Full Council Meeting on 14 July 2021</b></p> <p>At the last Full Council meeting held on 14 July 2021 (<a href="#">minute 12 refers</a>) Councillor B Burgess asked Councillor Jones (as Cabinet Member for Public Protection and Community Engagement) a question regarding CRB/DBS checks. The following response has been provided:</p> <p><u>Question:</u> At WSCC, a CRB/DBS is automatically carried out following elections, in your present Cabinet role what are your thoughts about renewing the practice here especially as we have so many new councillors?</p> <p><u>Response.</u> Councillors are not required to undertake DBS checks by virtue of being a councillor alone. However, in some cases where councillors are likely to come into contact with 'regulated activity' with vulnerable groups determined by the Disclosing and Barring Service (DBS) then they are eligible. This could be councillors involved in Children and Education services and Health and Adult Social Care. The Council is of course aware that some Elected Members may have had DBS checks, albeit in another capacity, for example if they are School Governor etc. Elected Members who do not carry out any of the specific educational and/or social service</p>

## PUBLIC NOTICE

### Temporary closure of Martyrs Avenue, Langley Green, 18th October 2021

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Martyrs Avenue, Langley Green, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Martyrs Avenue between London Road and Depot Road

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th October 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 22nd October 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while UK Power Networks undertakes 24hr West bound Road Closure on Martyrs Avenue between London Road and Depot Road to include a ban on the left turn (west bound) off Martyrs Avenue into Dobson Road. Ban of a left hand turn on to Martyrs Avenue from London Road. Ban of a right hand turn onto Martyrs Avenue off London Road. Addition lights to be in place at the junction with Dobsons Road to facilitate the one way to be put in place to allow entrance and exit of Dobsons Road.

The restriction will be in place **24hrs**

An alternative route will be signed on site but please visit <https://one.network/?tm=123713270> for more details.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
