The Regulations also require all local council tax support schemes (including those for working age and pension age persons) from 1 April 2022 to disregard Energy Bills Rebate payments received by applicants.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Southgate Avenue, Southgate , 28th March 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Southgate Avenue, Southgate, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Southgate Avenue from the junction with the Southgate Roundabout to the junction with Horsham Road.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 28th March 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 30th March 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Landbuild on behalf of West Sussex County Council undertakes Overnight Closures for two sets of junction improvements and carriageway surfacing works.

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 20:00 until 05:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
