Temporary closure of Bewbush Drive, Crawley, 27th June 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Bewbush Drive, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Bewbush Drive for a distance approx 76 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 27th June 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 30th June 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while T-Mobile (UK) Limited undertakes Road Closure from the junctions with Ellman Road to Cowfold Close with works taking place to the rear of No.16-23 to install a new telecom pole and cab

The restriction will be in place day-time only from 08:00 until 18:00
