NOTICE IS hereby given that in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the use of **Fernhill Road, Pound Hill** from junction with **Balcombe Road to junction with Peeks Brook Lane** is temporarily prohibited from **4/11/22**.

The restriction will be in place 24hrs

This emergency closure is necessary to allow **SES Water to repair broken surface** causing danger to road users.

It is anticipated the works will be completed by 10/11/22

Emergency vehicle, Residential and Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times
