Drivers simply purchase their permit online and receive an email notification when it is active.

Civil Enforcement Officers will be able to confirm if a vehicle has a valid digital permit via the vehicle registration number.

West Sussex County Council is increasing its charges for parking permits from 2 October. A resident permit will cost £58 and subsequent permits will cost £116. Non-resident permits will cost £350. There will no change to the cost of visitor permits.

Temporary closure of Ifield Wood, Rusper CP, 25th September 2023.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Ifield Wood, Rusper CP, in the Horsham District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Ifield Wood for a distance approx 88 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 25th September 2023 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 25th September 2023) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Balfour Beatty undertakes a road closure on Ifield Road from the Junction of Hillybarn Road for carriageway patching.

The restriction will be in place off peak only from 09:30 until 15:00

S106 Committed

£26,455.33 of collected S106 Library Monies has been committed by West Sussex County Council to the installation of modular shelving at Crawley Library, as well as providing high level work areas with individual access to power and USB sockets, tables, chairs, and a comfy seating area in the Business & Intellectual Property Centre.

The space will allow access to business 1;1s, events and online business resources for anyone seeking to start or expand a small business. This is part of a successful national library project being rolled out in libraries across the country.

In addition, £90,928.66 of collected S106 Transport Monies has been committed by West Sussex County Council retrospectively to the conversion of the mini roundabout at Ifield Drive/ Ifield Avenue, to a signalised junction. The total cost of the scheme was £442,000 and work was completed in November 2021.

This follows the transfer of the above S106 funds from Crawley BC to West Sussex County Council, following the conclusion of the S106 allocation process for both items. As per the standard practice, Crawley BC Local Planning Authority collected the S106 monies on behalf of West Sussex CC.
