RULE 16 - GENERAL EXCEPTION

Notice is hereby given that a key decision will be taken by the Cabinet on the following matter which has not been advertised 28 days prior to the date that the decision is required to be taken:-

**Housing Infrastructure Fund (HIF) Agreements.**

The date by which the decision must be taken makes it impracticable to defer the decision to allow the notice period to elapse. Therefore Rule 16 (General Exception) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules will be applied and a decision will be taken by the Cabinet on this matter at its meeting on 26 June 2019.

The reason it is necessary for this report to proceed to Cabinet at its meeting on 26 June 2019, is because of the gap between Cabinet meetings due to the summer recess, which may negatively impact on the Council's ability to enter a funding agreement. For that reason it is not practical to wait 28 days.
