## Temporary closure of B2114 Brighton Road, Pease Pottage, 23rd March 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic B2114 Brighton Road, Pease Pottage, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, from B2114 Brighton Road to Brighton Road for a distance approx 367 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 23rd March 2020 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 27th March 2020) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Breheny Civil Engineering undertakes Northbound Road Closure only from the new Pease Pottage service station roundabout to junction 11 gyratory (northbound carriageway of A23) to undertake laying of new tarmac on new road level

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
