Are works justified? Yes

The tree is located to the front of numbers 75 and 77 Worth Road. The works are part of a Borough wide survey of CBC owned trees to identify and undertake safety and general maintenance works, particularly to those within falling distance of houses and public spaces.

The tree requires containment/maintenance pruning due to its proximity to the highway, the tree has a codominant stem with a tight fork which is a potential weakness and failure point. The lower crown is also within the overhead telephone cables. It is considered that the crown lift works would have a negligible impact on tree health and amenity and they are therefore justified

- 1. This consent is valid for a period of two years from the date of this notice and shall only be carried out once.
