

PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of A264 Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound, 22nd June 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic A264 Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on A264 Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound for a distance approx 269 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 22nd June 2020 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 26th June 2020) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Edburton Contractors undertakes Westbound Road Closure between the Pease Pottage Roundabout and the Toligate Hill Roundabout to undertake carriageway surface including replacing high friction surfacing and road marks

The restriction will be in place overnight only from 20:00 until 05:00

An alternative route will be signed on site but please visit https://one.network/?tm=117068915 for more details.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
