

PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Copse Crescent to Crabtree Road , West Green Crawley, 28th September 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Copse Crescent to Crabtree Road, in West Green, Crawley under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The temporary footpath closure is scheduled to commence on 28th September 2020 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 2nd October 2020) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while UK Power Networks undertakes 24hr Footpath Closure for the Installation of a new electricity supply for a customer. Closed full length between Crabtree Road and Copse Crescent.

The restriction will be in place 24hrs a day

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
