



# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Temporary closure of Beehive Ring Road, Crawley, 18th December 2020

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Beehive Ring Road, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Beehive Ring Road for a distance approx 47 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th December 2020 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 18th December 2020) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while BT undertakes Road Closure from the junctions with Airport Roundabout to Airport Way Services Roundabout with works taking place at the junction Beehive Ring Road to allow access underground structure for new fibre connection

The restriction will be in place **off peak only** from 09:30 until 15:30

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
