

PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of London Road Southbound, Langley Green, 2nd March 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic London Road Southbound, Langley Green , in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on London Road Southbound for a distance approx 1893.00 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 2nd March 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 4th March 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Gatwick Airport undertakes the decomission of a scaffold in Gatwick Terminal – closed between Airport Way offslip and Gatwick Road. The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 21:00 until 04:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
