RULE 16 - GENERAL EXCEPTION

Notice is hereby given that a key decision will be taken by the Cabinet on the following matter which has not been advertised 28 days prior to the date that the decision is required to be taken:-

Extension to Coronavirus Act Protections from Evictions in Crawley Homes

The date by which the decision must be taken makes it impracticable to defer the decision to allow the notice period to elapse. Therefore Rule 16 (General Exception) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules will be applied and a decision will be taken by the Cabinet on this matter on 30 June 2021.

The reason it is necessary for this report to proceed to Cabinet at its meeting on 30 June 2021, in order to formalise a stated intention of the administration following the Annual General Meeting held on 28 May 2021. The Government protections to be extended came to an end on 31 May 2021 and the decision to extend needs to be made as soon as possible.

For that reason it is not practical to wait 28 days.
