Rule 16.2 –
Reinstate the Small Grants Programme

Notice is hereby given that a key decision will be taken by the Cabinet Member for Public Protection and Community Engagement on the following matter which the General Exception Notice applies and the report has not been advertised 28 days prior to the date that the decision is required to be taken:-

The date by which the decision is to be taken makes it impracticable to defer the decision to allow a complete 28 day period of the exemption notice to elapse. Therefore Rule 16.2 General Exception of the Access to Information Procedure Rules will be applied and a decision will be taken by the Cabinet member on or after 21 September 2021.

The reason it is necessary for this decision to proceed, is to ensure specific delegations for the reinstatement of small grants process and to complete the process within agreed budgets. For that reason it is not practical to wait 28 days.
