



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of St Marys Drive, Crawley, 18th October 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic St Marys Drive, Crawley, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on St Marys Drive, from the railway bridge on St Marys Drive to just before Hazlewick School Close

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th October 2021 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 19th October 2021) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Drain Line on behalf of West Sussex County Council undertakes a Road Closure taking place between Hazlewick School Close and Chaucer Road with the work taking place from the railway bridge on St Marys Drive to just before Hazlewick School Close to conduct drainage investigations

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 10:00 until 16:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
