Section 106 Monies - Q4 2020/21 to Q2 2021/22

Report of the Head of Economy and Planning, PES/389

1. Purpose

- 1.1. Developers are often required through Section 106 planning agreements to make financial contributions towards the provision or improvement of infrastructure if a need is generated by the new developments. These monies must be spent as set out in the planning agreements and in accordance with government guidance.
- 1.2. This report summarises all the S106 monies received/spent and committed to project schemes between Q4 2020/21 & Q2 2021/22.

2. Recommendations

3. Reason for Recommendations

3.1. The Council's Policy Statement of S106 Monies through planning agreements requests an update to be reported to the Planning Committee.

4. S106 Monies Received (to date) 2021/22

- 4.1. Between Q4 2020/21 & Q2 2021/22 a total of £748,263.64 of monies were paid to the Council by developers in accordance with their obligations under the S106 agreements with the local planning authority.

7. Available Funds and Potential Future Spend

- 7.1. Officers at the Council have identified a programme of infrastructure projects to the value of £1,848,493.84 which are intended to be delivered by 2024/25. The individual projects that make up this programme will be subject to the existing S106 approval process before any formal commitment is made. As of 1 October 2021, there remains £600,752.44 of uncommitted S106 monies for which projects have yet to be identified.
