Temporary closure of Metcalf Way, Crawley, 3rd February 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Metcalf Way, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Metcalf Way for a distance approx 50 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 3rd February 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 6th February 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while T-Mobile (UK) Limited undertakes 24hr Road Closure from the junction of County Oak Way with works taking place to the rear of Currys to install new ducting for 5G telecoms

The restriction will be in place **24hrs**

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
