

Green Homes Grant Local Authority Delivery Scheme (LAD2)

Crawley homeowners & private tenants on low incomes and living in hard to heat homes are being encouraged to check if they are eligible to receive help under a new scheme to make their homes warmer, lower their carbon emissions, and save money on their fuel bills.

The Government's Green Homes Grant Local Authority Delivery scheme, managed by Warmworks on behalf of the council, offers a wide range of measures including:

- Wall insulation
- Loft insulation
- Renewable heating systems (such as Air Source Heat Pumps)
- Double/triple glazing (to replace single glazing)
- Energy efficient doors
- Thermostats and heating controls

Warmworks will arrange a survey in the homes of eligible householders to agree what work will be carried out. Then, a local accredited and registered sub-contractor team completes the installation of the agreed energy-efficiency measures, before an independent inspection assesses the completed work against rigorous quality standards.
