## Temporary closure of Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound, Crawley, 24th February 2022

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound, Crawley, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Crawley S/western Bypass Westbound for a distance approx 270 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 24th February 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 25th February 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while West Sussex County Council undertakes Westbound Closure on Crawley Bypass between Pease Pottage Roundabout to Tollgate Hill Roundabout Essential repairs to the anti-skid on the A264 approach to the pedestrian crossing Works being undertaken by Breheny Civil Engineering - 07786968087

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 20:00 until 06:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
