



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Metcalf Way, Unknown, 16th May 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Metcalf Way, Unknown, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Metcalf Way for a distance approx 34 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 16th May 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 20th May 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while T-Mobile (UK) Limited undertakes Road Closure between the junctions of County Oak Way with works taking place opposite Currys for installation of new telecoms pole

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 08:00 until 18:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
