



# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Temporary closure of Hawmead, Worth CP, 20th February 2023

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Hawmead, Worth CP, in the Mid Sussex District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Hawmead for a distance approx 35 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 20th February 2023 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 24th February 2023) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while UK Power Networks undertakes Road closure between the junctions of Hallsland and Cranston Way with works taking place o/s and opposite no. 3 for disconnection of service

The restriction will be in place **24hrs**
