RULE 16.3 –
Town Hall Site Redevelopment Phase 2
& Phase 1 Final Account

Notice is hereby given that a decision will be taken by the Full Council on the following matter which the Exempt Exception (16.3 Exempt Exception Notice) has not been advertised 28 days prior to the date that the decision is required to be taken:-

Town Hall Site Redevelopment Phase 2 & Phase 1 Final Account

The date by which the decision must be taken makes it impracticable to defer the decision to allow a complete 28 day period of the exemption notice to elapse. Therefore Rule 16.3 (Exempt Exemption) of the Access to Information Procedure Rules will be applied. It would be impractical to defer the decision by 28 days and it would be unreasonable to take the decision in public.

The report will proceed to Cabinet on 12 July 2023 with a decision being by the Full Council on this matter on 19 July 2023. The reason it is necessary for this to proceed as soon as possible of the gap between Cabinet meetings and Full Council due to the summer recess, which may negatively impact on the Council's ability to proceed. For that reason it is not practical to wait 28 days..

For the reasons stated it is not practical to wait until a future date.
