

The Council is currently undertaking a review of polling districts, polling places and polling districts as required Section 18C of the Representation of the People Act 1983. The review is looking at the location of polling stations and the electors that are allocated to them.

Responses are invited from electors within the Borough as well as from persons or bodies with expertise in relation to access to premises for persons with any form of disability. Public notice of the review is being given and details will be published on the Council's website.

The deadline for responses is 5th November 2023. All responses will be made available for public inspection and will be reported to the next meeting of the Governance Committee with a recommendation to the Council meeting on Wednesday 13th December 2023.
