Temporary closure of Guinness Court to Woodmans Hill, Crawley, 11th March 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Guinness Court to Woodmans Hill, Crawley under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Guinness Court to Woodmans Hill, Crawley for a distance approx 50 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 11th March 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 15th March 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while UK Power Networks (SWA Code: 7004) undertake 24hr/day footpath closures between

Guinness Court to Woodmans Hill
St James Walk, next to houses nr 18 - 19
Finsbury Close, footpath behind houses nr 34 -37 for connection works.

The restriction will be in place **24hrs/day**

Access will not be maintained during works and the diversion route will need to be followed.
