



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Blindley Road, Crawley, 7th August 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Blindley Road, Pound Hill, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Blindley Road for a distance approx 37 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 7th August 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 7th August 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Thames Water undertakes a daytime road closure o/s no.6 between the junctions with Heathfield and Balcombe Road for carriageway repair works.

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 09:30 until 15:30
