

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Temporary banned movement on Southgate Avenue, Southgate, 9th September 2024.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily banned the **right** turn from, Southgate Avenue, Southgate, into **Hawth Avenue** in the Southgate district under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Southgate Avenue for a distance approx 10 metres

The temporary ban of movement is scheduled to commence on 9th September 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 13th September 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Landbuild undertakes refurbishment of traffic signals.

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 19:00 until 06:00
