



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Malthouse Road, Southgate, 18th October 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Malthouse Road, Southgate, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Malthouse Road for a distance approx 23 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th October 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 18th October 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while West Sussex County Council undertakes a daytime road closure between the junctions with James Place and Brewer Road for carriageway patching works.

The restriction will be in place **day-time only** from 08:00 until 16:00
