



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Brighton Road, Southgate, 13th November 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Brighton Road, Southgate, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Brighton Road for a distance approx 19 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 13th November 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 13th November 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd undertake a night-time road closure between the junctions Pegler Way and Crawley Avenue with line painting works taking place on the level crossing.

The restriction will be in place **night-time only** from 00:20 until 05:30

An alternative route will be signed on site but please visit <https://one.network/?tm=139161240> for more details.

Access will not be maintained during works and the diversion route will need to be followed.
