



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Fernhill Road, Pound Hill, 18th November 2024.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Fernhill Road, Pound Hill, in the Crawley District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Fernhill Road for a distance approx 20 metres.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 18th November 2024 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 22nd November 2024) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while South East Water undertake 24hr/day road closures between the junctions with Balcombe Road B2036 and Peeks Brook Lane for water connection works. Works located at the junction with Balcombe Road..

The restriction will be in place **24hrs/day**

Access maintained for residents and pedestrians.
