

## West Sussex Electric Vehicle Chargepoint Network – On-Street Public Consultation

West Sussex County Council (WSSCC) launched an online public consultation via '[Your Voice Survey](#)' on 1 November, regarding the phase three – part two roll-out of on-street electric vehicle (EV) charge points. Literature will be delivered to households in close proximity of the proposed locations and there will be a contact telephone number and email address for any residents that do not have access to the online consultation, which closes on the **29 November**.

Parking restriction changes are not being proposed at the moment, therefore non-EVs will be able to park as before.

## West Sussex EV Chargepoint Network – Background

In 2021 WSSCC and district and borough Councils (Adur and Worthing Councils, Arun District Council, Crawley Borough Council, Horsham District Council, and Mid Sussex District Council) appointed Connected Kerb as the EV chargepoint provider for the county via a 15-year concession contract to deliver chargepoints in locations on streets and in local car parks.

Requests for chargepoints from residents and Members are strongly encouraged to ensure demand is met in all wards.
